

- 2000: ISMIR = International <u>Symposium</u> on MIR
- 2002: ISMIR = International <u>Conference?</u> on MIR
 - Steering committee
- 2008: ISMIR= International <u>Society</u> for MIR
 - Non-profit and independent organization
 - Members steadily increasing (ca. 2000 members)
 - Every two years, society members elect a board
 - The symposium becomes "ISMIR conference"
- From 2000 to 2022, there has been 23 ISMIR conferences !!!




We participated in the **Deep Learning Indaba 2022** in Tunis.






In 2022...

Financial Status Budget Usage


- Continue making ISMIR accessible: students, WiMIR, outreach to increase diversity, scholarships


