What does the S in ISMIR mean?

- 2000: ISMIR = International <u>Symposium</u> on MIR
- 2002: ISMIR = International <u>Conference</u> on MIR
 - Steering committee
- 2008: ISMIR = International <u>Society</u> for MIR
 - Non-profit and independent organization
 - Members increasing (~950 members in 2024, up from ~850 in 2023)
 - Every two years, society members elect a Board
- From 2000 to 2023, there have been 24 ISMIR conferences!

ISMIR Bylaws Election

- The ISMIR board in coordination with WIMIR put forward a change to the society's bylaws, introducing the role of WIMIR liaison to the board, ensuring alignment between ISMIR and WIMIR activities.
- The current version of the Society's bylaws can be found at: https://ismir.net/pdfs/ISMIR-Bylaws.pdf
- The board is proposing to amend the bylaws by introducing an additional clause in Section 4:
 - 4.7 One of the three Members-At-Large will act as a liaison for the WIMIR (Widening Inclusion in MIR) group, ensuring the alignment between society and group activities and initiatives
- Results: bylaws change was approved (94% of voters agreed with proposed bylaws change)







After a three-year hiatus, we plan to revive MIREX starting in 2024. Our goal is to introduce new tasks and datasets that reflect the rapid advancements in computer music research. We envision the new MIREX serving the following key purposes:

- Benchmarking: Establishing well-defined, fair benchmarks to assess music-related models and algorithms
- 2. **State of the Art**: Showcasing state-of-the-art models and evaluating how they address—or fail to address—current music-related challenges
- 3. **Communication Channel**: Providing a platform for summarizing and analyzing research progress, fostering communication within the ISMIR community and across related fields


Motivation and Background

- ISMIR culture on continuous improvement and innovation


Open Review Initiative Timeline

- 1. 2023.07 Online discussions, forming a working group with two subgroups
 - a. **Survey** subgroup: Zhiyao Duan, Hugo Flores García, Magdalena Fuentes, Anna Huang, Blair Kaneshiro, and Justin Salamon
 - b. Webinar subgroup: Brian McFee, Oriol Nieto, and Shuqi Dai
- 2. 2023.11 Conducted an **initial survey** at ISMIR 2023, received 47 responses
- 3. 2023.11 Discussions at ISMIR 2023 Society Meeting and Unconference
- 4. 2023.11 Held a **webinar** for further discussions
- 5. 2024.03 Released a **revised survey** to Music-IR mailing list
- 6. 2024.04 Closed Survey, received 116 responses
- 7. 2024.06 Released survey summary results at ISMIR 2024 Blog
- 8. 2024.07 ISMIR 2024 SPC **adopted practice** of "publishing anonymous reviews of accepted papers with both authors and reviewers consent".


ISMIR Open Review Survey Key Results (N=116)




116 responses

ISMIR Open Review Survey Key Results (N=116)



- More than 80% of survey takers prefer some kind of open peer review for ISMIR
- 0.9% chooses "It is not clear to me yet whether ISMIR should adopt open review. I would like to see evidence of the benefits of openreview before making a decision"
- 18.1% of survey takers think that ISMIR should not adopt any form of open review.
